

Instructions for SAPIC Grants

There are two types of SAPIC grants available, Workshop and General.

The applicant must be a SAPIC member, (dues \$25 individually, \$35 household, \$40 business, which may accompany the grant application if a non-member).
The grant amount will be issued up to \$500.

Workshop Grants:

The purpose of workshop grants is to specifically promote cemetery care and gravestone repair and does not include related physical improvements such as brush removal, fencing, signs, chemicals, etc.

The grant will be specifically applied to a cemetery workshop.

SAPIC may sponsor and partially finance the activity. They may elect to contribute additional funds.

Local activity arrangements will act as host, (county agency, school, private individual, Cemetery Commission, township, etc.

The host will make all arrangement and be responsible for the following: the workshop, location, announcements, registration fees and expenses.

The instructor must be qualified to teach appropriate preservation methods.

Upon completion, a short report will be given to SAPIC.

GENERAL GRANT

The purpose of the general grant is to assist financially with the cost of repair to gravestones and related physical cemetery improvements such as brush removal, signs, chemicals, fencing, etc.

The grant will be specifically applied to a cemetery.
